Welcome to a culinary stage to savour! Between Cancale and Le Vivier-sur-Mer, you ride past one of the Bay of the Mont Saint-Michel's major areas for mussel cultivation, reputed for its high-quality moules de bouchot (grown on posts and granted AOP status).

The route

Cycling off from Cancale, you follow minor parish roads up to a fork at the place named Les Boulais where you then head off to Le Vivier-sur-Mer. Note that the circuit through Cancale isn't signposted with the Vélo maritime logo. Also, be careful crossing the larger county roads. After you've reached the fork in the route, then follow the logo signposting the Vélo maritime route.

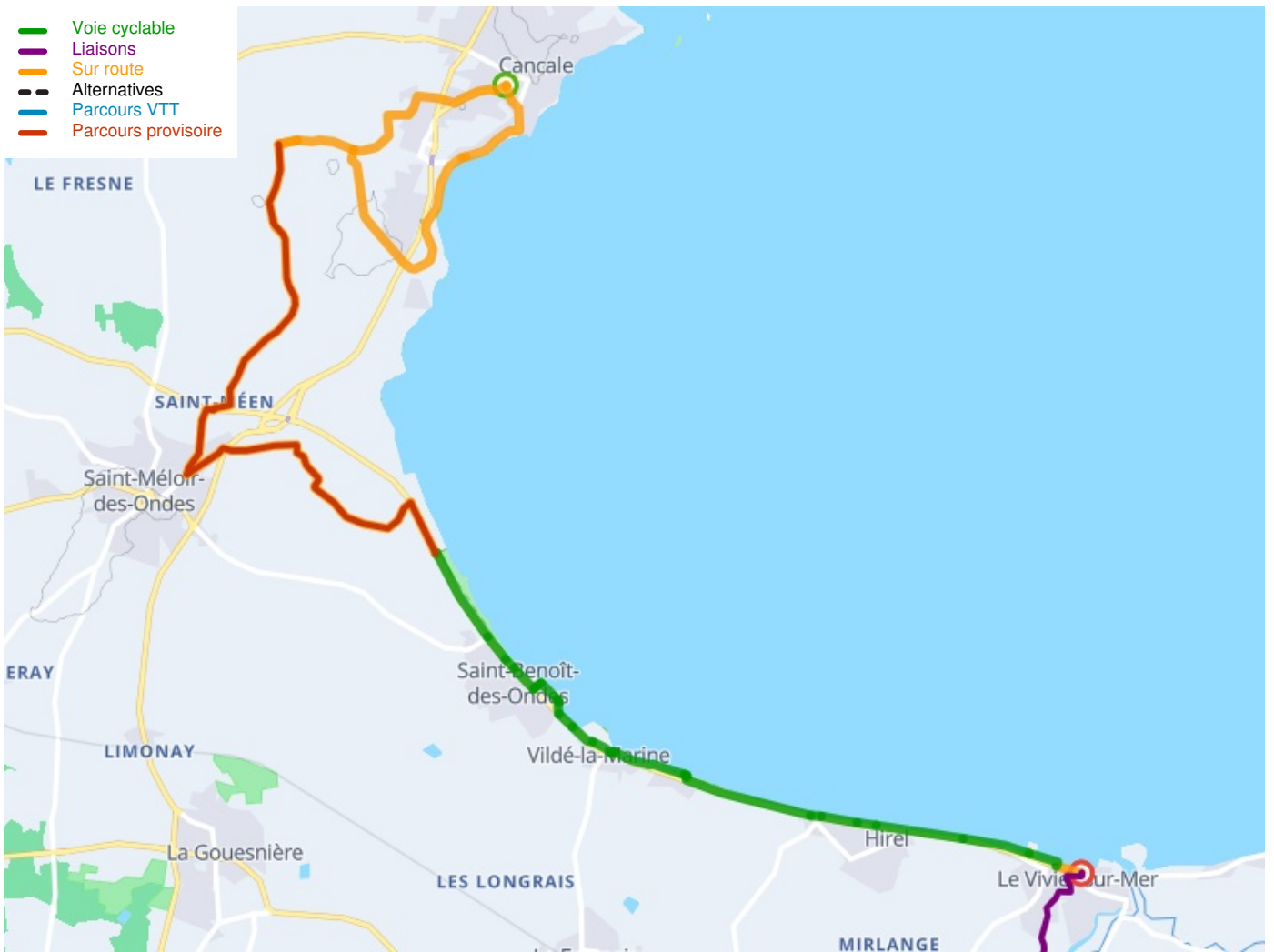

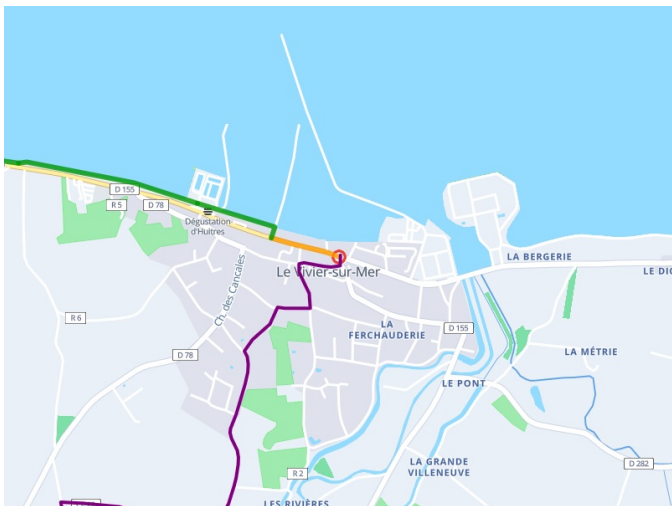
