

Dieppe / Le Tréport

La Vélo maritime / EuroVelo 4



Your cycling trip along the highest white limestone cliffs in Europe draws to an end as the Vélo maritime leads you along the last portion of eastern Normandy's Côte d'Albâtre stretch of coast, with typical steep little valleys, or valleuses, cutting through to the sea up to Le Tréport. This resort's charms, including its multicoloured villas and lively fishing port, will encourage you to stop for a well-deserved rest.

The route

On this last stage through Normandy, you cycle along roads shared with motorized traffic up to Le Tréport. You cross the drawn-out parish of Petit Caux, then you cycle along the D16 road taking you on via Criel-sur-Mer.

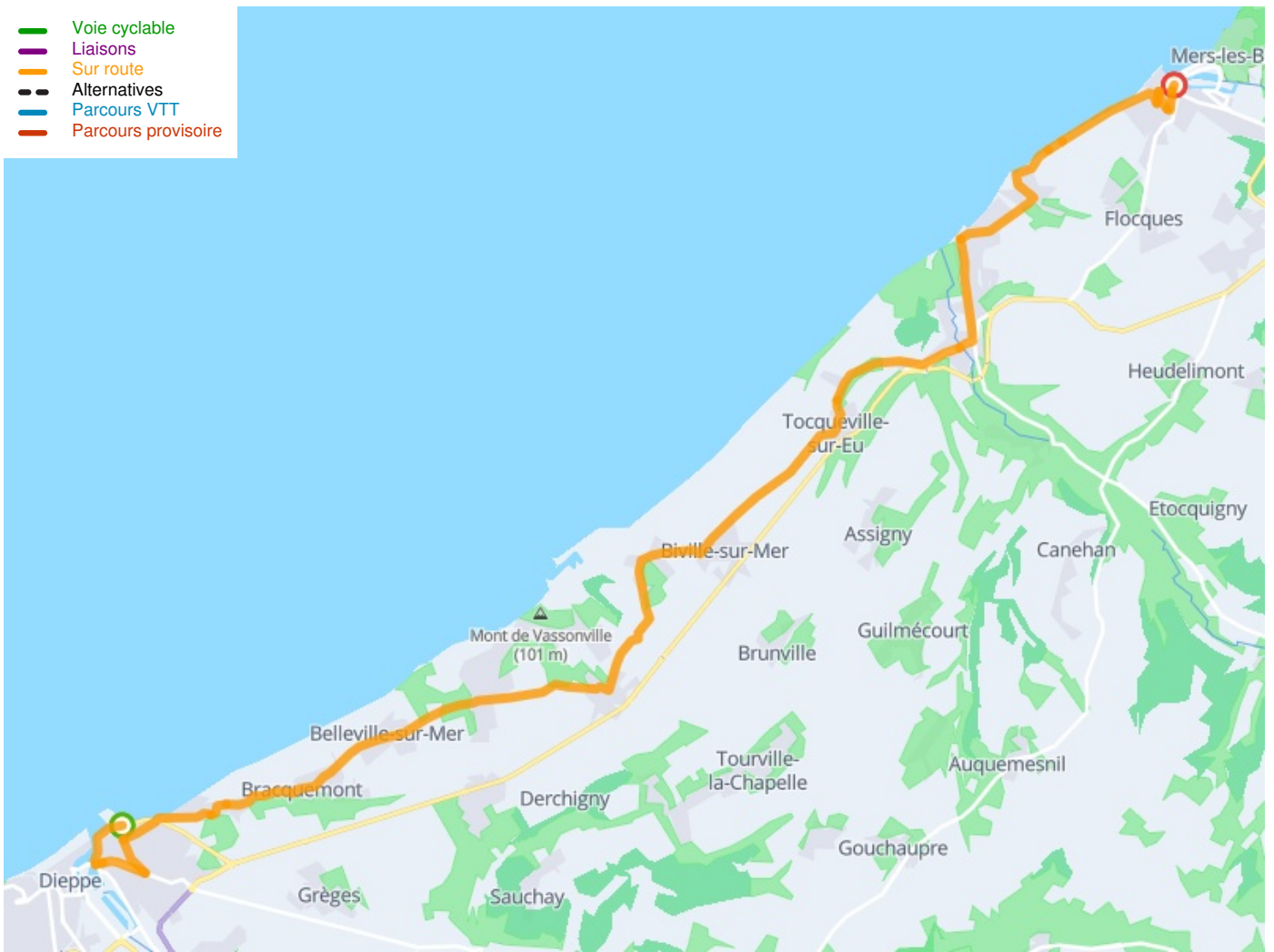

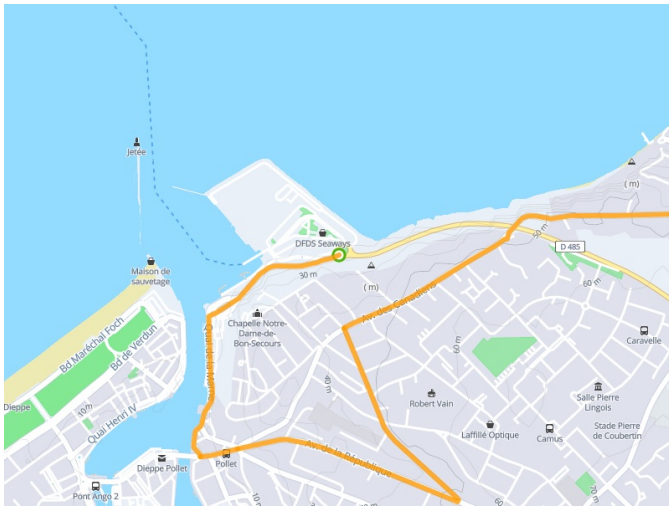
