

# Étretat / Fécamp

La Vélo maritime / EuroVelo 4



Leaving behind Étretat's shingle beach and spectacular cliffs, the Falaises d'Amont and d'Aval, your Vélo maritime journey continues into the green countryside behind the coast, passing via the villages of Saint-Léonard and Les Loges, to be enjoyed as you cycle through them. Then you descend towards Fécamp, once a major centre for the medieval Dukes of Normandy.

## The route

You start this stage by crossing the villages of Les Loges and Saint-Léonard. Continue on to join the D940 road. The route then leads you straight on to the Renneville campsite, which you have to cross through.

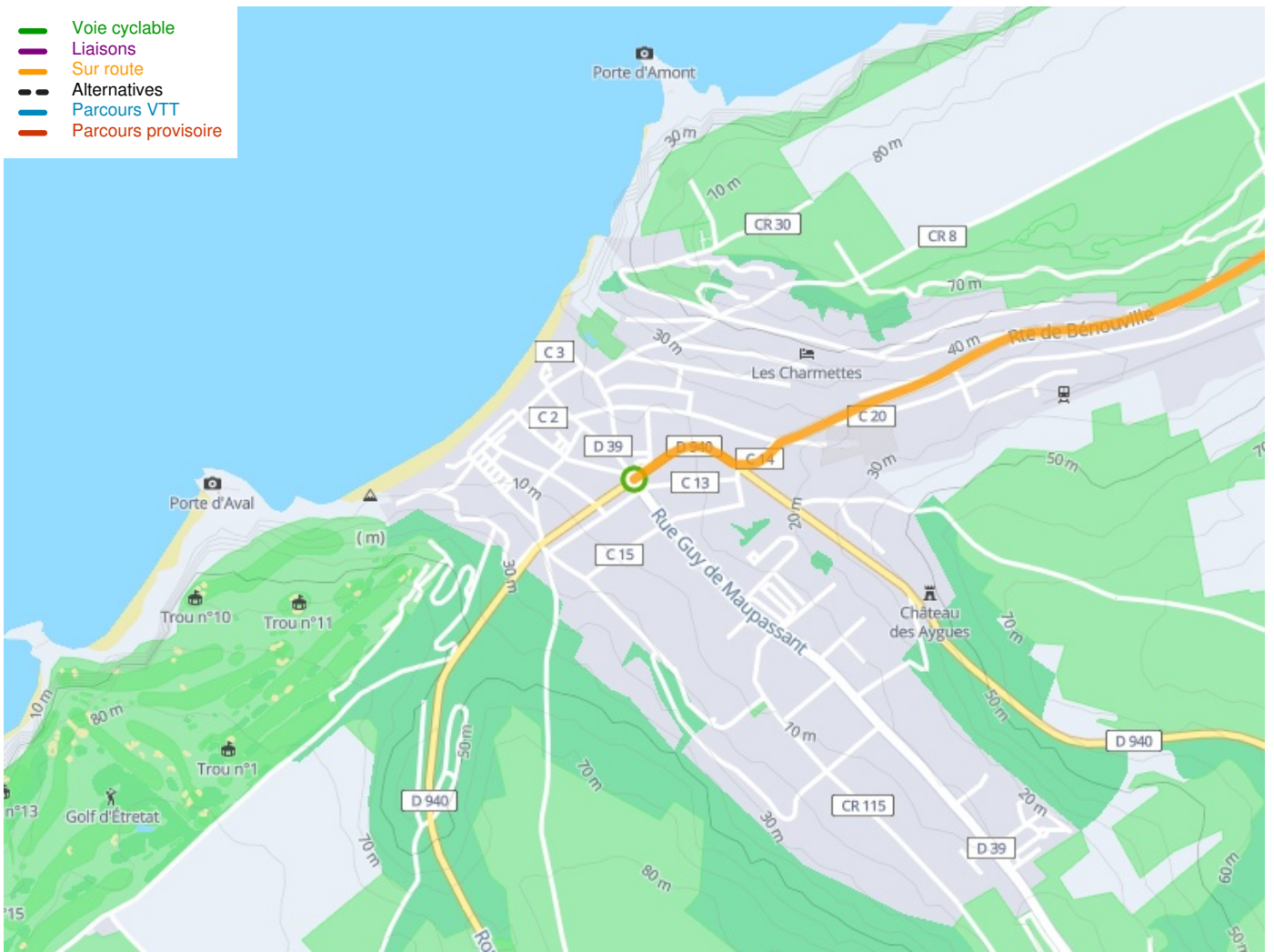

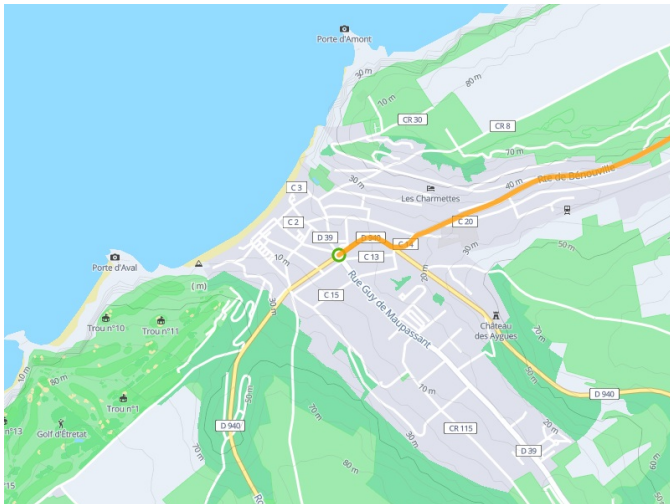
